West Jaya is the 7th consecutive semi-tender rig constructed and delivered on time and on budget by Keppel FELS for Seadrill in recent years. West Jaya is a new and improved version of semi-tender rigs which will add significant value to its future clients.

I would also like to take this opportunity to recognize the contribution of the Keppel FELS project team led by Mr Tan Lye Soon. Your team has worked hard to deliver Seadrill a quality rig.
